Dr. Heilbron completed his undergraduate degree at the University of Cape Town (South Africa), and then practiced as a rural family physician in Newfoundland and Manitoba for 4 years. He completed Internal Medicine and Cardiology training at the University of British Columbia in 1995. He has Level 3 Certification in Cardiac Computed Tomography and is a Diplomate of the Certification Board in Cardiac Computed Tomography and a Fellow of the Society of Cardiovascular Computed Tomography. He has been based at St. Paul's Hospital since 1997, where he has a busy clinical practice, attends in the Emergency Department, on the wards, and in the Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory. He is currently Medical Director of the Electrodiagnostics Program at St. Pauls' Hospital / Providence Heart and Lung Institute, and a Clinical Associate Professor at the University of British Columbia. His interests include electrodiagnostics, noninvasive cardiac imaging and information technology.

Dr. Dodek did post graduate training in Canada and USA. He is certified as a specialist in Internal Medicine and in Cardiology in both countries. He studied on a sabbatical at Harvard University. He served as director of cardiac catheterization and interventional laboratories at St Paul's Hospital for twenty years where he pioneered coronary angioplasty and balloon valvuloplasty. He is an author of over 100 published medical articles. Dr. Dodek is Clinical Professor Emeritus of Medicine UBC. He was on the Board of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC for ten years, where he was the Chair of the Ethical Standards Committee and the President. He is the Cardiology Consultant to LifeLabs since 2001. This includes the monitoring of physicians who interpret ECG's and Holter Monitor scans. He established a Quality Assurance peer review program for LifeLabs cardiology services.
