



THE B.C. LUNG SCREEN TRIAL

Thank you for your interest in The B.C. Lung Screen Trial. This study is a pilot program taking place at Vancouver General Hospital that offers lung cancer screening using low-dose CT scans to participants at higher risk of developing lung cancer.

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To be eligible for this study, participants must:

- be between **55 and 80 years of age**
- **be current or former smokers**
- have either **≥30-pack-years** of smoking history or an estimated **6-year lung cancer risk ≥1.51%** based on a validated risk prediction model (calculated by study staff)

We encourage you to refer all eligible and interested individuals aged 55-80 who have smoked for 20 years or more, and our study staff will follow-up with your patient directly to obtain their detailed smoking history and determine their eligibility.

If you have patients that meet these eligibility criteria, they may be referred to this study through one of the following methods:

1. Affix patient contact information to the blank referral form and fax to 604-675-8098 (our staff will call your patient and complete the form with them)
2. Ask your patient to complete the referral form and fax the completed form to 604-675-8098
3. Ask your patient to call the study centre office directly at 604-675-8088
4. OSCAR EMR users may also upload an E-Form version of our referral form from the OCUS website (OSCAR Canada Users Society), complete it online, and fax it to the study office at 604-675-8098

Study patients with CT-detected lung nodules or masses suspicious of lung cancer will receive an expedited referral to the *Lung Cancer Rapid Access and Nodule Management Clinic* at the BC Cancer Vancouver Centre. In addition, all current smokers will be given smoking cessation advice and will be referred to the QuitNow smoking cessation program.
