Day2	10-Sep	Arrive Tokyo Upon arrival, by hotel shuttle bus transfer to hotel.
Day3	11-Sep	Tokyo - Xian via Japan Airlines JL609 (0945/1325) By hotel shuttle bus transfer to airport for flight to Xian Upon arrival, meet and transfer to hotel. Afternoon, visit the City Wall, Big Wild Goose Pagoda followed by the night tour.
Day4	12-Sep	Xian Full day sightseeing includes the Terra-Cotta Warriors, Banpo Neolithic Village. Huaqing Pong. Banquet with Tang Enjoy an authentic Dumpling Dance Dinner Show
Day5	13-Sep	Xian - Urumqi by afternoon flight (Flight takes about 4hrs) After breakfast, visit the Shaanxi Provincial Museum before fly to Urumqi
Day6	14-Sep	Urumqi Today, you'll visit the famous Tianchi Lake. Afternoon visit the Nanshan Mountain
Day7	15-Sep	Urumqi Today, you'll visit the Hongshan City Park (Red Mountain) & Xinjiang Museum to see its mummies.
Day8	16-Sep	Urumqi - Kashgar (Kashi) by flight After breakfast, transfer to airport for flight to Kashgar. Upon arrival, meet and transfer to hotel. Afternoon, you'll visit the old town of Kashgar Etigar Mosque, Apak Hoja Tomb.
Day9	17-Sep	Kashgar (Kashi) An excursion tour to the Karakuli (means the black) Lake also known as the Sister Lakes. Return to Kashgar in the evening. Tonight you'll enjoy a delicious Roast Lamb Banquet.
Day10	18-Sep	Kashgar (Kashi) -air- Urumqi -coach- Turpan This morning, you'll have an good experience to see the Big Sunday Bazaar. After that, you'll be transferred to airport for flight to Urumqi. Upon arrival, take a coach ride to Turpan.
