Ukraine and Black sea Cruise CME report.

The 2 week CME cruise began at Kiev, the capital of Ukraine. It is a vibrant city and the place of the Orange revolution that gave birth to the democratic Ukraine. Clean and safe, it is a city filled with history with orthodox cathedrals mixed with Cossack and Lenin statues.

The highlight was the coast of Black sea. The ship cruised along the Dniepro River, the third largest in Europe, going through 5 locks to enter the Black sea. The first port we visited was Odessa, which is a truly cosmopolitan, multicultural city. It is an important portal to the previous communist regime with a large number of different ethnic groups.

The next port is the previously mysterious Russian naval base for the Black sea fleet, Sevastopol. It is now very much a tourist place, with high end fashion stores and well equipped tourist facilities. Here we traveled to Yalta, the place of the post-WWII meeting where Stalin, Churchill, and Roosevelt drew the current map of Europe. The most picturesque sight on the way is the Swallow's nest castle on a cliff.

We had regular meetings on the ship for educational purposes. The small group was very actively interacting and gave much feedback during the sessions, which spanned from psychology to surgery and included topics ranging from infant formula to bariatric surgery.

The trip ended by cruising back to Kiev, stopping by a few more cities along the way. That gave us the chance to see the less beaten track in Ukraine and experience the true Ukrainian life. We also learned a few Ukrainian words and some Russian phrases. The one I still remember is "Yellow Blue Bus". Feel free to ask someone from our group or a Russian friend for the meaning of the phrase.
